 - b. Island oak tree removal Double oak is dead and will be removed 8/20. Cost is \$2000. Another tree will be placed further down the island when weather is cooler and with the 2026 budget.
 - c. Results of Compliance Committee meeting of May 10, 2025
 - d. Increase of HOA Annual Fee for CY 2026 to \$1,425
 - e. 597 Wells Landing Drive called regarding Agricultural Committee letter. Don confirmed that railroad ties or landscape timbers can be installed to replace the

rotting timber. Don offered to measure and transport the landscaping timber and show her son how and where to install them.
